GENERAL RESPONSE PROCEDURES

1. Maintain safety of victim and team
2. If life threatening call 911 and or USCG VHF Channel 16
3. Provide appropriate life saving and first aid care
4. Contact DAN as needed 919-684-9111
4. Transport or arrange transport to next level of medical care as needed
5. Notify UCSC DBSP staff and appropriate group supervisors of incident
6. If appropriate, secure diver’s gear – record gauge readings and number of turns to turn valve off – do not breakdown gear or bleed pressure from system - leave setup complete as it came out of the water
