

Lab Recycling Guide



Non-contaminated, **clean lab plastic containers** and **conical tubes** may be recycled. To be accepted, containers must be clean, triple rinsed, and labels must be "X" out. EH&S provides a [guide](#) on determining if container is hazardous. Recycling bin located:

Alcohol cans and **metal shipping containers** may be recycled. To be accepted, alcohol cans must be triple rinsed. Recycling bins located:

Rigid plastics (**pipette tip boxes** and **plastic pails**) may be recycled. Recycle bins located:

→ PSB Loading Dock

→ Sinsheimer 1st Floor

→ E&MS Loading Dock

→ Engineering 2, 2nd Floor

→ Thimann Loading Dock
