## Lab Recycling Guide



Non-contaminated, clean lab plastic containers and conical tubes may be recycled. To be accepted, containers must be clean, triple rinsed, and labels must be "X" out. EH&S provides a guide on determining if container is hazardous. Recycling bin located:  $\rightarrow$  PSB Loading Dock



Alcohol cans and metal shipping containers may be recycled. To be accepted, alcohol cans must be triple rinsed. Recycling bins located:

- $\rightarrow$  PSB Loading Dock
- $\rightarrow$  Sinsheimer Loading Dock
- $\rightarrow$  E&MS Loading Dock
- → Thimann Loading Dock

Rigid plastics (pipette tip boxes and plastic pails) may be recycled. Recycle bins located:

- $\rightarrow$  PSB Loading Dock  $\rightarrow$  Sinsheimer 1<sup>st</sup> Floor
- $\rightarrow$  Biomed 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Floor
- $\rightarrow$  Engineering 2, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor
- → E&MS Loading Dock
- → Thimann Loading Dock



Kimberly-Clark Nitrile Gloves may be recycled. Collection bins located:

 $\rightarrow$  E&MS 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, C Block  $\rightarrow$  PSB Room 101  $\rightarrow$  BioMed Room 208  $\rightarrow$  SSI Room 439  $\rightarrow$  Sinsheimer Room 137  $\rightarrow$  Baskin Room 202  $\rightarrow$  Delaware Room C145  $\rightarrow$  Long Marine Lab Mail Room
